- Organisation and active participation in **conferences and trade exhibitions** (inside and outside NL);
- Linking of Dutch businesses with our embassy network and with foreign companies
- Focus on target countries but flexible when serious market opportunity pops up.











## **Offshore Wind Energy**

- Coordinating role in consultations with trade organisations (HHWE, NWEA, IRO, NMT);
- Active partner in the public-private sector platform <u>Wind & Water Works</u>;
- Organisation and support in incoming and outgoing missions and webinars;
- Info/contact point for trade colleagues at the Netherlands embassy network;
- Support in market studies and development of export guides (<u>Offshore Wind</u>
  <u>Guide</u>);
- Active role in number of key offshore wind events.
- Focus countries:
  - Prio 1: France, Ireland, Poland, Baltics, USA, China, Japan, Korea and Taiwan;
  - Prio 2: England, Scotland, Brazil, India, Indonesia and Vietnam.

## **Green Hydrogen**

Ministry of Foreign Affairs

- Dutch hydrogen sector is growing: from SME's up to large energy companies
- Focus on business opportunities abroad and focus on development of international supply chains of hydrogen
- Leading role in the further development of the *Platform Waterstof Internationaal* (PWI)
  - o Creation of consortia and recruiting of members (now 150 members of which 90+ companies) bringing together of sub-themes;
  - o Knowledge dissemination (website, newsletters) and providing topical information (events calendar, EU calls, etc.)
- Organisation and support in incoming and outgoing missions and in webinars;
- Info point for trade colleagues at the Netherlands embassy network;
- Support in market studies and development of export guides (<u>Hydrogen Guide</u>);
- Active role in number of key offshore wind events such as the World Hydrogen Summit (R'dam, 9-11 May)
- Focus countries: Germany, Belgium, Spain, Portugal, Nordics, Chile, Brazil, Uruguay, Austalia, Gulf region, Namibia, South-Africa, USA, Canada. (CERF focus countries among others: Morocco, Egypt, Jordan and South-Korea)
